



## Pacifica Potter's Wheel Repair

### How to straighten a wobbly wheel head:

1. Turn the power ON on the potter's wheel. Rotate the wheel head slowly. As the wheel head is rotating, mark the vertical high spot with a marker. (See top photo on following page.)
2. Turn the power OFF on the potter's wheel.
3. Get a small block of wood; make sure that it is free of any debris and metal objects, such as nails.
4. Place the block of wood on the marked high spot at the rim of the wheel head. (See bottom photo on following page.)
5. Get a hammer or mallet, and tap the block of wood. You may need to repeat this procedure a few times. Always check the wheel head after tapping on it by rotating it at a slow speed.
6. You should be able to see (and feel) the correction by looking across the wheel head's rim while rotating the wheel at slow speed.
